#### Legislation

- 519 will probably pass
  - Scholarship and Loan forgiveness
- Learning Community

- trouble getting a bill that can be agreed upon by Supts
- if common levy goes away - puts \$10 mill back in state aid for everyone else
- No change in Ag value likely to happen yet
  - developers have been really lobbying against this
  - data shows that overall land value has been going up throughout the state - ag just got hit recently.
  - vote is split so nothing may come out of committee
- Driver's License for "dreamers" likely to be one that NCSA takes a stand on
- Lottery funds - 20% will probably come to K-12 (almost all went to post secondary) almost all in the form of competitive grants
- Career Academy - came up today, no news just yet.
  - Distance Learning included in this
  - NOT a Millard Bill - other districts are creating ties and partnerships with higher ed and even businesses.
  - College and Career Ready - Workforce Development
  - Not going to be in state aid
- TEOSA study bill will likely pass
- Minimum wage for student workers is up for question - should NCSA take a stand?
  - student worker rate must be at least minimum wage
  - probably won't take a stand either way on this bill
- Revenue Committee will put as much as possible into property tax relief - but it won't be by putting into state aid.
